## ABM Reflection

Jeremiah 4.1-10; Psalm 71.1-6; 1 Corinthians 13.1-13; Luke 4.21-30

Sometimes the truth that God tells us through his word can be hard to bear. Jesus told a difficult truth to the Jews in the Synagogue in his hometown. Deep within his message was the truth that God's love is for everyone and not just for the Jews - demonstrated by his acts of healing and mercy to gentiles in difficult times. Today we can rest assured that, as surely as God formed us in the womb and knew us, he has love for us that breaks down all barriers.
