From the Prayer Book pg 202 Peace

Amen.”

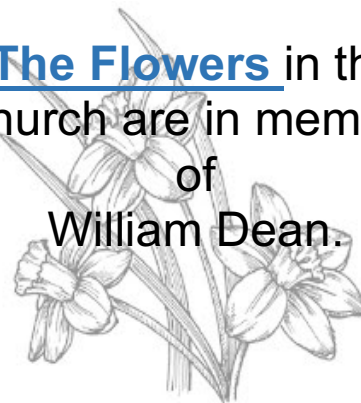
