From the Rector's Desk

A prayer that has been said by millions of Christians throughout history and by this congregation at Christmas (2016).

Prayer of Confession

If we have arrived at a time in our lives when the Christmas story no longer excites or renews us:

Have mercy upon us, O God.

If, in the midst of the riches of the gospel of Jesus Christ, we live like paupers:

Have mercy upon us, O God.

If the life of Jesus fails to challenge us, or his death and resurrection cease to comfort us:

Have mercy upon us, O God.

If, in the face of the world's great need, we hoard the gospel like misers:

Have mercy upon us, O God.

So that we may be forgiven and renewed:

Restore to us the joy of salvation.

So that we may be a loving community:

Restore to us the joy of salvation.

So that we may clothe our good intentions with the garments of action:

Restore to us the joy of your salvation, through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen

The point of this prayer is not guilt, but inspiration that transforms. In fact, the point of all our worship is, that constant transformation from the rich heritage that we have occurs constantly. We cannot return to the past, but we do need to be enlivened by it. Every story, every experience we have had in our Faith, is for us a beautiful reminder of God's grace and our chance to be in relationship with Him because of that.

This year is our opportunity to be a people who *Enthroned* Christ in our lives, *Engage* in the Harvest that is before us, are *Empowered* in our Worship, breathe in the *Enlightenment* of the word of God through His Spirit, and, be God's people of *Encouragement* to each other and this world.
