From the Rector's Desk

Walking in the Steps of Jesus

What is it to walk in the steps of Jesus? Stephen shows us clearly what it means to walk in the steps of Jesus. Acts 7:55 – 59 “⁵⁵ But filled with the Holy Spirit, he gazed into heaven and saw the glory of God and Jesus standing at the right hand of God. ⁵⁶ “Look,” he said, “I see the heavens opened and the Son of Man standing at the right hand of God!” ⁵⁷ But they covered their ears, and with a loud shout all rushed together against him. ⁵⁸ Then they dragged him out of the city and began to stone him; and the witnesses laid their coats at the feet of a young man named Saul. ⁵⁹ While they were stoning Stephen, he prayed, “Lord Jesus, receive my spirit.” ⁶⁰ Then he knelt down and cried out in a loud voice, “Lord, do not hold this sin against them.” When he had said this, he died.”

Many get caught up in the death of Stephen rather than seeing the beauty of His worship. Stephen saw Christ and God in Heaven and he was content for whatever came next because he was walking in Jesus' way, truth and life. This is what it is to worship completely, it is a goal, a passion, a desire that every person who walks with Christ needs to be yearning for. Not all will witness as Stephen did, in fact most won't, but it is what we are called to be like.

Jesus says in John 14:6 - 7 “⁶ Jesus said to him, “I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me. ⁷ If you know me, you will know my Father also. From now on you do know him and have seen him.”

If we are convinced of Heaven and our Messiah the Christ, then we need to walk in His way, truth and Life.

It's a challenge, not because of a choice we make to do it as choice in this is not an option, it is a challenge because of the life it is.
