"Recently I spent some time in Lebanon with Syrian refugees. I met a Muslim woman who had fled with her husband and three children. One night she had a dream and saw Jesus Christ holding them in the palm of his hands. He said to her, "Don't worry, I will take care of you." The next morning when she woke up, she found there was food miraculously in her house. Her husband also had the same dream! I say all this to remind us that everything we do as a ministry is to connect people with Jesus. We want to see nations restored from the inside out as we believe Jesus is the only answer to the worlds' brokenness."
