From the Rector's Desk

Bringing up a child in the way of the Lord

Many people have asked me the question, "why don't my children come to church?"

It's a hard question to answer because in the end we can tell our children how we think they should live, we can give them the best opportunities, we can raise them providing the best Christian environments, the greatest opportunities, getting them baptised as children, confirmed as teens and even going to children's church or youth group. We give them everything they may ever need, including all the love we have.

But some still choose to not go to church.

On the other side of the coin I spend time with many people in their twenty's and thirty's telling me that they keep hearing their parent's words and behaviours coming out of their mouths and in their behaviours, and it drives them mad.

The interesting thing to me is that the proof is in the pudding, our children are affected by our lives, choices and example. They see what we do, hear what we say, watch our experiences and it affects them and their lives.

The answer becomes obvious, if we show (shine) Christ's love as Christ loved the church, live that way and talk in the same way Jesus spoke, our children will see, hear and experience Christ's love in our lives.

We can't force our children to make the choices we made, but we can Love them as Christ loved the church and shone his light in us to them.

Whatever the circumstances, whatever the trials we or they face, it is only through the love of Christ that we will be able to know the nourishment that is the bread of life.

Believe, shine and live the life that is given by Christ.

Jn 6:47-51

⁴⁷ Very truly, I tell you, whoever believes has eternal life. ⁴⁸ I am the bread of life. ⁴⁹ Your ancestors ate the manna in the wilderness, and they died. ⁵⁰ This is the bread that comes down from heaven, so that one may eat of it and not die. ⁵¹ I am the living bread that came down from heaven. Whoever eats of this bread will live forever; and the bread that I will give for the life of the world is my flesh."
