2 Bless the Lord you heavens: sing his praise and exalt him for ever. 3 Bless the Lord you angels of the Lord: sing his praise and exalt him for ever. 4 Bless the Lord all people on earth: sing his praise and exalt him for ever. 5 O people of God bless the Lord: sing his praise and exalt him for ever. 6 Bless the Lord you priests of the Lord: sing his praise and exalt him for ever. 7 Bless the Lord you servants of the Lord: sing his praise and exalt him for ever. 8 Bless the Lord all you of upright spirit: bless the Lord you that are holy and humble in heart. Bless the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit: sing his praise and exalt him for ever. The night has passed, and the day lies open before us; let us pray with one heart and mind.

Silence is kept.

As we rejoice in the gift of this new day, so may the light of your presence, O God, set our hearts on fire with love for you; now and for ever. Amen.
