From the Rector's Desk

How do you pray and seek God every day? One of the things that is great about liturgy is the ability for it to be read across culture. Western Culture with its individualism tends to shun liturgy because we don't like being told what to do or say. More the loss for us when doing that ignores such a rich tool of worship.

As I stated before liturgy crosses culture **and** society. It's not about you, it's about worshipping God. The benefit of a good liturgy is that when we hear the words we are saying, and action them, we are honouring God in His glory.

Why don't you try it for a week, a Prayer Service to do every day where God is first and foremost in your life.
