Trinity Foundation – Western Wall

The NSW Heritage Office approved a grant of \$60,000 in May 2011 to assist with work on the western wall and some of the slate roof. Part of the funding requirements meant that the scaffold on the outside had to be erected by the end of May 2012.

The old cement render on the exterior wall was removed (some with great difficulty) by the end of July 2012 and our Heritage Architect, James Nicholson, carried out extensive research on whether the wall should be rendered or joints repointed.

The old loose and cracked cement render was in fact trapping water between it and the brickwork and probably causing a lot of the water penetration problems on the inside of the western wall – compounded by salt leeching through the bricks and the original calcimine paint being painted over rather than washed off.

Because of the poor quality of a lot of the bricks, it has been decided to

re-render the wall with lime plaster, which will allow the bricks to breathe. This is specialised work and quotes were obtained from two Sydney contractors. A quote of \$39,402 has been accepted and work started last Tuesday – expected to be completed by the end of September 2012, when it is hoped work will start on reslating the roof of the Sanctuary and Priest's vestry.

The reason why the render was not started sooner is that the lime render freezes in low temperature and then requires to be reworked.

Meetings will be held every Friday from now until the Fair - at 11:00am in the Parish Centre.


